CHILDREN/YOUTH



WORSHIP THEME

Communion with Others: what we are called to do, what we are called to celebrate?

Today we celebrate World Communion Sunday. Celebrating the time when Jesus welcomed the children to come to him, our theme is "It is to Such as These." On this day, we are invited to think closely of our brothers and sisters in other Christian denominations; to think about what unites us, and what, sadly, still divides us. Although barriers continue to divide us from other denominations, when we eat of one consecrated loaf, we signal our unity with Christ and seek the oneness of the whole communion of saints on earth and in heaven. It is indeed, for such as thesebroken, opinionated, wayward, but forgiven people—that Jesus prays for unity "that they may be completely one, so that the world may know that you have sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me" (John 17: 23b). We give witness to this hope on World Communion Sunday.
