First Sunday in Advent

Many of us treasure coming home for the holidays: sometimes to a literal place, sometimes to a place of memory, sometimes to familiar settings and rituals we have embraced. What about when coming home is a frightening prospect? Or what about, as with the 125 people displaced this week from Kensington Manor right here in Calgary, we suddenly find that there is no place to come home to? Or when home becomes a death-trap, as for the 71 victims of the terrible Grenfell Tower fire in London?

Coming home is the theme of our Advent series, one that we happily acknowledge has been inspired by the United Methodists in the U.S.A. Coming home is also about making room: for hope, for rituals. For Godbreaking-into the world. For Jesus. As the Rev. Bret Stuart Myers has written, "We are called to have faith and to prepare for the coming of Christ in our world. But [m]ay we unlearn the rules of our society as we welcome in your ways of loveliness and grace. Remove from our way the boulders of apathy, the briars of self-centeredness, and the quagmires of acquisitiveness. Inspire us to imagine your better world, and to live in the way that would make it real; as did the Prince of Peace whose coming we honor."
